## ROCK ISLAND COUNTY CANDIDATES

County officeholders make spending, administrative, and regulatory decisions that can impact pro-life initiatives. All candidates who have an opponent in their race were sent a survey by Quad City Right to Life, either for the primary or the general election. Informational literature and a self-addressed, postage-paid envelope were included. Candidates were asked questions about issues pertinent to local government: the use of county tax funds to pay for abortion/abortion referrals or for any agency that provides, promotes or refers for abortion, abortion coverage in R. I. County's employee health insurance plan, the provision of contraceptives and abortion referrals to students in Rock Island County's two school-linked health clinics, parental notification, informed consent, health and safety standards for abortion clinics and "women's health clinics," doctors' admitting privileges at a nearby hospital, regulations regarding the sanitary and dignified disposal of fetal remains, zoning regulations, and statistical reporting. **Races with no opponents or survey responses are not shown.**
